FRANCESCA MARTINEZ
TUESDAY 5 OCTOBER

Francesca Martinez is an award winning comedian, actress, writer and campaigner. She has appeared on numerous TV shows and her most recent tour 'What The **** Is Normal?!' took in 140 dates around the world. She is an active campaigner who speaks about issues such as austerity, climate change and disability rights, her appearance on Question Time in 2019 where she highlighted the devastating impact of austerity on disabled people went viral. She has mild cerebral palsy but much prefers the word wobbly!



BARONESS DOREEN LAWRENCE OBE
TUESDAY 5 OCTOBER

Baroness Lawrence of Clarendon OBE is one of the UK's most well-known anti-racism campaigners. After her son, Stephen, was tragically murdered in a racially motivated attack in 1993 she began campaigning to improve racial equality. Baroness Lawrence's campaigning led to a judicial inquiry which, in the Macpherson Report, found the Metropolitan Police to be institutionally racist - one of the primary causes of their failure to solve Stephen Lawrence's case. Baroness Lawrence founded the Stephen Lawrence Day Foundation which aims to inspire a more equal, inclusive society and provide opportunities for marginalised young people across the country. She is widely regarded as one of the most influential women in public life in the UK.

Lisa Power MBE is a sexual health and LGBTQ+ rights campaigner and LGBTQ+ history consultant. She is one of the co-founders of Pink Paper and Stonewall. Lisa was the first openly LGBTQ+ person to speak at the United Nations. Previously Policy Director of the Terrence Higgins Trust (for which she is still an advisor), Lisa also was a consultant in the creation of the Channel 4 series It's A Sin. She is also the author of 'No Bath But Plenty of Bubble: Stories from the London Gay Liberation Front'.



LEILANI FARHA
DAY TWO

Leilani Farha is the former UN Special Rapporteur on adequate housing and Global Director of 'The Shift', an NGO committed to enshrining housing as a human right. The shift advocates for action to end homelessness, unaffordability, evictions and inadequate housing. Leilani has developed global human rights standards on the right to housing through her reports on homelessness, rights-based housing strategies and the first UN guidelines for the implementation of the right to housing.
